#### Dalhana

- Period → 12<sup>th</sup> C.AD
- Commentary → SS → "Nibandha Sangraha" → Available, Popular
- Native place → Ankola near Madhura of Mandanka Kingdom
- Belongs → Brahmin family → his ancestors were also expert in the field of medical science
- His forefathers:: Govinda → Jayapala → Bharapala → Dalhana
- He revised present work after referring the available commentaries on SS by Jejjata, Gayadas, Bhaskar etc
- Useful for many Ayurveda scholars because of easier mode of presentation compared with others.

### Gayadas

- Period → 11<sup>th</sup> C AD
- Commentary → SS → "Nyaya Chandrika"
- Commentary → CS → Charaka chandrika
- Nyaya Chandrika also known as Naya Chandrika, Chandrika & Panjika
- Gayadas Commentary on Nidana Sthana → available in Bikanir Raja & published by Nirnaya Sagar press Bombay along with commentary of dalhana
- Court Physician → King Mahipala → Kingdom Of Gouds

#### Haranachandra Chakravarthi

- Period → 19<sup>th</sup> C.AD
- Son → "Anandachandra Chakravarti"
- Commentary → SS → "Susrutardha Sandipani"
- Disciple → Gangadhar Roy
- Commentary published → Calcutta → 1908
- Conduct surgery → As per procedure told in SS
- Died →1934
