MANDIBLE


- The unpaired mandible is the bone of the lower jaw and bears teeth
- It consists of an anterior U-shaped body and two rami (right and left) project upward

Body

➤ The body has the external and internal surfaces and upper and lower border

➤ Inferior border has triangular prominence called mental prominence

➤ At the two lateral end ends of the triangle are the mental tubercles form the chin
