1. अपतर्पण (Fasting) One of the Shodhana chikitsa

अपतर्पणमाद्य उपक्रमः First chikitsa for all vranashopha. Considered as Pradhana upakarma among all due to it **Ashukari guna**

Apatarpana also called as Langhana/Upavasa should be advised in aama condition along with dosha, dhatu and mala dushti to bring them back to normal condition.

To break the pathology and to limit the progression of disease.

2. आलेप (Application of medicinal paste)



Used in Vranashopa and extremely painful vrana.

Aalepana dravyas are used based on the dosha predominance.

Mainly used for shamana of local kupita dosha and reduce vedana and daha locally. It dose Manah prasanata, vrana shodhana, shopa nivarana, vrana utsadana and ropana.

3. परिषेक (Irrigation)



Wound irrigation or sprinkling with dugdha, ghrita, kwatha etc. based on dosha predominance to pacify dushita

Mainly does **shamana of sthanika doshagni**.

Does daha and vedana shamana.

4. अभ्यङ्ग (Anointing)

Anointing or massage with oil to soften the vranashopha.

Local abhyanga help in relieving srotoavarodha and prevents progression of disease.

6. विम्लापन (Gentle massage)

Done in case of alpa, shulayukta vranashotha.

7. उपनाह (Warm Poultice)

Used in Ama avasta of vranashopha

Leads to early resolution or suppuration

8. पाचन (Induction of suppuration)

Alepa of Teekshna-ushna dravyas on Pachymana vranshotha

Leads to Pakwavastha.

9. विस्नावण (Blood letting)

Recommended in Kathina shotha, Vedanayukta, vishama and Savisha vrana.

Helpful to reduce pain in newly formed Vranashotha.

10. स्रेह (Oleation)

As a brihmana karma in vataja vrana or as a poorvakrama of visravana Useful in newly formed vranashotha, Can also be used in Vrana upadrava avastha.

11. वमन (Emesis)

Newly formed vranashotha, Prescribed in utsanna mamsashopha, kapha dushti.

12. विरेचन (Purgation)

In jeerna vrana/ chirakari vrana, Pitta-Vataja vrana.

Shodhana dravyas for cleaning the Dushta vrana and Ropana dravya for enhancing the healing of suddhavrana.

- कषाय(Wound Cleaning) For Dushtavrana Shodhana Kashaya dravyas are used, for suddhavrana Ropana Kashaya dravyas are used.
- वर्ति (medicated wicks) Indicated in Puyayukta, Dushta and Suddhavrana. Varti is useful in Sukshmamukhi, NadiVrana and deep Vrana.

- रसिक्रया Shodhana and Ropana Rasakriya are used for Dushta and Sudhavrana respectively.
- अवचूर्णन (Dusting) Twaksthita, Sthiramamsi, Avikrutakruti and GhrishtaVrana.
- त्रणधूपन (Fumigation) Vataja, Tivrashulayukta and Sravi Vrana. Fumigation is done with many preparations, which are mainly containing Ghrita, Vacha, Sarjarasa etc.

Utsadana is for rising of the beds and cavities of deep Vranas. क्षारकर्म- Shodhana of Chirakari, Kandu, Kleda and SravayuktaVrana. For this application of Teekshna, Ushna Gunatmak Kshara is used.

प्रतिसारण - impart natural skin colour to a discolored scar by Applying medicinal Churna.

अवसादन - UnnatmamsiVrana and is achieved by applying Avasadan drugs and Madhu अग्रिकर्म - Atiraktasravi, Sandhichchinna, Ashmarinirharan Shastrakarmaja Vrana रोमसञ्जनन - produce hair on a scar which is lacking hair. Like rubbing Hastidanta masi

मृदुकर्म - in Vataj, Kathina, AlpamansiVranas with the help of lotions, Ghrita etc. दारुणकर्म - in MruduVrana, Kashayarasatmaka Dravyas are कृष्णकर्म - The blackening of white cicatrix by using medicinal drugs such as Bhallatak Taila.

लोमापहरणं - remove Roma from Romavyapta and Nonhealing Vrana. It is done by using Yantra as well as by applying Medicinal Dravyas. For this purpose, shankha Churna & haratala in 2:1 ratio mix with amla dravya and

ৰন্ধ - It is necessary to keep the Vrana away from foreign bodies, to keep gatra in position and to promote healing.

Doshadushti in Vrana, they are
lubricated, either heated or cooled and
tied over Vrana. It serves to generate
heat or cold and retain medicated oil at
Vrana

कृमिन्न - destruction of Krimi and Relieving Kandu. It includes washing by Kashaya and application of Kalka of Krimighna Dravyas.

बृंहण indicated for Vataj, Ruksha, and Chirakari Vrana and in Krusha Rugna.

रक्षाविधान It is the measure adopted to protect the Vrana from Krimi, Jantu etc. It is done by keeping Vranitagara very clean and by Dhoopana by Krimighna and Rakshoghna Dravyas.

Mantra vidhi, yama, niyama should be followed.

Discussion

- Acharya Sushrutha described Vrana and Vrana Upakramas in detail. It
 is easy to learn and apply the principle of saptopakrama in the
 management of surgical wounds whereas Shashtiupakrama provide
 us lot of option for the management of wound in different stages.
- Acharya has no where mentioned that all the 60 upakramas should be used in all type of vrana, he has given few examples/lakshana while explaining each upakramas and its applicability. Hence it's the management of vrana should be based on the yukti and avasta of the vrana.
- Along with the local vrana chikitsa, the attention has been given on the Vranita and his general health, which includes various systemic treatment mentioned in the Shastiupakramas of Sushruta.
